

## Submission Guidelines for Articles

To submit an article for consideration in *Mobility Humanities*, please adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Articles should be approximately 8,000 words or less in length (including Abstract, Keywords, footnotes and Works Cited).
2. Provide a separate cover page which gives the title of the article, complete contact information for author (s) (full name, affiliation, and email address), a total word count, and additional information such as funding and ORCID (if applicable). Affiliations and email addresses will be posted online for indexing/abstracting purposes. For the title, please use **bold** with an initial capital letter for any proper nouns.
3. The cover page should also have a one-paragraph abstract (limited to 200 words) of the contents of the article and 5 to 8 keywords. The abstract should not duplicate the text verbatim but rather include the research question or puzzle, identify the data, and give some indication of the findings. Keywords should be drawn from the content and not duplicate the article title, listed in alphabetical order, and separated by commas; only proper nouns should be capitalised.
4. The first page of the text of the article should have only the title of the article at the top, abstract and keywords. The name of the author(s) should NOT be included.
5. Figures:
  - Any type of illustrative visual material – for example, a photograph, map, line drawing, graph, or chart – should be labelled Figure (abbreviated Fig.) and assigned an Arabic numeral.
  - The title of the figure and the source information should be provided below the image.
  - Both the figure and the caption must be centre-aligned.
  - For the artwork, artist name, artwork name, creation year, and location and information should be provided as a caption.  
E.g.) Fig. 1. Berthe Morisot. *Reading*. 1873. Cleveland Museum of Art.

- If there is no title for the figure, please provide the reason for it on the cover page.
6. Tables:
    - Table must be numbered and titled.
    - The title of the table should be provided above the table.
  7. The manuscript should follow the MLA style. View the [Mobility Humanities Manuscript Style Guidelines](#) to ensure your manuscript conforms to this reference style.
